Interrogatory No. <u>15</u> :	Mr. Falatogo's intent when exiting the vehicle was unclear. Despite testimony from Dr. Alpert that this was a 'pre-flight behavior' and alarm by the officers, jurors were not convinced Mr. Falatogo had malintent. He very well could have not initially noticed the officers and been proceeding to enter the Z-mart.
Interrogatory No. <u>20</u> :	Falatogo reached in the direction of the gear shift once, and it could be reasonably said twice, but not three times. The reach was also towards a common storage area in vehicles after Officer Hay asked for something with Falatogo's name on it. Falatogo could have been moving to search through the storage area.
Interrogatory No. <u>28</u> :	"Actual test resistance" is vague, however Falatogo continued to apply upward force rather than submitting to officers or laying flat on the ground. Regardless of attempts to or not to reach, the position of his body indicated resistance. Additionally, from Officer Keller's perspective, an objectively reasonable officer, there was no alternative.
Interrogatory No. <u>31</u> :	As relates to Officer Keller, I do not believe he is criminally liable. Unfortunately, due to SPD policies, he really had no other options. Morally, I believe SPD policy is the culprit of Mr. Falatogo's death. At the time of the shooting, the gun was away from Mr. Falatogo, but officers continued to indicate to Officer Keller that deadly
Interrogatory No. <u> </u> :	danger is was imminent. This is an inquest into Mr. Falatogo's death, not specifically Officer Keller, and the interrogatories should more critically examine all involved officers. Officer Hay, through his rapid, escalatory communication, should also have been evaluated.
